WHEREAS, The Board finds this resolution appropriate and necessary to protect, preserve, and improve the rights, privileges, property, peace, safety, health, welfare, comfort, and convenience of Webster County and its citizens, all as provided for in and permitted by section 331.301 of the Code of Iowa; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board to accept the bid from Graves Construction Co., Inc. in the amount of \$945,560.95 and award the associated contract(s) to the same;


